The Friends of Galveston Island State Park (FoGISP) is an independent non-profit group organized to support, assist, and promote the mission and activities of Galveston Island State Park (GISP) under the agreement with Texas Parks and Wildlife Department. As part of our outreach in education we are initiating the Terry Gaustad Memorial Scholarship for students who have performed volunteer service hours to the programs of GISP. Hours must be logged into the VMS system.

Scholarship Awards will be announced July 1, 2024, and will be paid directly to the institution that the student will be attending.
